Brothers, Both Employees, Charged in McDonald's Robbery

Two brothers, a current McDonald's employee and the other a former employee, have been charged with last weekend's shooting and robbery at the restaurant in southeast Shelby County.

Delando Summerall, 24, and his brother, Orlando Nichols, 21, both of Memphis, were arrested after several law enforcement bureaus worked jointly on the case. Sheriff's Office General Investigation Bureau detectives led the investigation.

Sheriff's detectives were assisted by the Sheriff's Office Street Crimes Bureau, Southaven Police Department and officers with the Safe Streets Task Force which is comprised of F.B.I agents, Memphis Police officers and Sheriff's Deputies.

Investigators say Summerall helped plan the robbery at the McDonald's at 3805 Hacks Cross Road just after 11 p.m. Sunday. Summerall, who works at the restaurant, told

detectives he got Nichols, his brother and former employee, to rob the night manager, Tiffani Chambers. Chambers was shot during the robbery. After the shooting Nichols took cash from the restaurant office.

Chambers has been linked to the crime but has not been charged. Deputies arrested her boyfriend, Aaron Bey, 24, earlier this week for using her car as the getaway vehicle. Chambers remains in the Regional Medical Center recovering from a hip wound.

Deputies continue to question other restaurant employees and more charges are likely. Both Summerall and Nichols both face charges of Aggravated Assault, Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony, Reckless Endangerment and Theft of Property Under \$500. Pictures of all suspects are being sent in separate files.
