Confrontation Leads to Shooting in Southeast Shelby County

A southeast Shelby County man was shot last night after a confrontation with some acquaintances near a convenience store.

Antonio Hudson, 20, remains in stable condition today at the Regional Medical Center. Sheriff's detectives say Hudson's mother found him near the front yard of their home in the 4200 block of Winding Hollow Way

Hudson told investigators he had earlier met with some acquaintances at a nearby convenience store. A confrontation occurred and Hudson left.

While walking home, Hudson told Sheriff's detectives the group followed him in a dark colored SUV and someone in the vehicle fired several shots at him.

Hudson's mother initially rushed him to the nearby Methodist Minor Medical Clinic. He was later taken by ambulance to the Regional Medical Center.

Deputies are still trying to determine what led to the confrontation. No one has been arrested.
