Sheriff's Corrections Deputies Set to Graduate

The Shelby County Sheriff's Office will graduate 34 new Corrections Deputies Thursday. The graduation will be held on January 29 at the Al Chymia Shrine Temple at 5770 Shelby Oaks Drive. The ceremony begins at 7 p.m.

"We are pleased to graduate these Corrections Deputies. These men and women are to be commended for their efforts to serve our community by working at the Shelby County Jail," said Shelby County Sheriff Mark H. Luttrell, Jr.

The Corrections Deputies have been part of a rigorous seven-week training course which included the latest jail security methods, physical agility and Sheriff's Office policies and procedures.
