### **Argument Leads To Murder in Southeast Shelby County**



**Charity Tate**

A North Carolina man died today at The Regional Medical Center from a gunshot wound he received earlier this week during an argument with friends in southeast Shelby County. The woman who argued with the man has been charged with Criminal Reckless Homicide.

Torre Grady, 22, of Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, was visiting Corey and Charity Tate at their home at 7468 Midnight Cove.

Charity Tate and Grady are both in the Army. Grady was a guest at Tate's house Sunday evening.

Just before 2 p.m. on Monday, Grady, Charity and her husband, Corey, got into an argument.

Sheriff's detectives say that's when Charity Tate got a gun and pointed it at Grady who was shot in the face. Deputies took Tate into custody soon after the shooting.

This was the first homicide investigated by Deputies in 2009.
