Argument between Soldiers Leads to Murder in Shelby County



Charity Tate

An Army soldier shot earlier this week by a fellow soldier died today at The Regional Medical Center. The other soldier has been charged with Criminal Reckless Homicide.

Torre Grady, 22, of Atlanta, was visiting Corey and Charity Tate at their home at 7468 Midnight Cove.

Charity Tate and Grady served in the same Army unit at Fort Campbell, Kentucky.

Grady was a guest at Tate's house Sunday evening. Just before 2 p.m. on Monday, Grady, Charity and her husband, Corey, got into an argument.

Sheriff's detectives say that's when Charity Tate got a gun and pointed it at Grady who was shot in the face. Deputies took Tate into custody soon after the shooting.

This was the first homicide investigated by Sheriff's Deputies in 2009.
