Icy Roads Cause Traffic Delays in Sheriff's Office Patrol Districts

Sheriff's Deputies still report some icing on bridges and overpasses this morning. There were 16 traffic crashes between 6 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. on roads patrolled by Sheriff's Deputies. No one was seriously hurt.

Despite the icy conditions, all roads remained open during the freezing rain and snow. The Sheriff's Office Inclement Weather Policy remains in effect.

Motorists involved in non-injury traffic crashes in Arlington, Lakeland and the unincorporated areas of Shelby County should exchange insurance and personal information and then report the traffic crash to Deputies after the winter weather conditions improve.

Drivers may file crash reports at the Shelby County Sheriff's Office Traffic Bureau at 11670 Memphis-Arlington Road in Arlington. However, in traffic crashes involving injuries, drivers should immediately call 9-1-1.
