Sheriff's Deputies Find Pot Farm in Berclair Neighborhood

Sheriff's Deputies looking for a fugitive today found both him and a marijuana farm growing inside his Berclair home.

Just before 10 A.M., Sheriff's Fugitive Bureau Deputies knocked on the front door of 4610 Owen. The man they were looking for, Charles Millington, 30, opened the door and immediately tried to run out a back door. Another Sheriff's Deputy was waiting and took Millington into custody.

Millington was a fugitive for missing court in Lauderdale County for Driving on a Suspended License. As Deputies arrested Millington, they smelled marijuana.

Sheriff's Narcotics Deputies were called and more than 50 marijuana plants, some two-feet high, were discovered growing in pots in a bedroom. Deputies also found one bag of packaged marijuana. No other persons were in the house.

Millington was charged with Possession, Distribution or Selling of a Controlled Substance. He also faces the Failure to Appear charge from Lauderdale County.
