Deputies and Emergency Services Volunteers Respond to Storm Damage

Sheriff's Deputies continue to assess damage caused by the storm that moved into Shelby County this evening. The majority of damage was in north Shelby County bordering Raleigh, Bartlett and Millington.

Parts of Highway 14 near Bartlett are blocked by trees that have blown over. There are also trees down along Highway 64 near Lakeland and other areas in east and northeast Shelby County including the intersection of Raleigh-Millington at New Allen.

Deputies have responded to 44 storm-related incidents this evening, 34 involving trees blocking roadways. There have been other reports of traffic crashes and downed power lines. No one has been hurt seriously in any of the incidents.

Reserve Deputies and volunteers with the Sheriff's Emergency Services Bureau are assisting fulltime Deputies as they patrol neighborhoods affected by the storm in the unincorporated areas, Lakeland and Arlington.
