Unlocked Car Door Leads To Credit Card Spending Spree



Sheriff's detectives continue their search for two women who stole a purse from a vehicle and then used credit cards to buy more than a thousand dollars worth of gas, clothes and shoes. A store security camera captured images of the two women during their shopping spree.

Investigators believe the women stole the purse last Friday (July 24) just after 5 p.m. from a vehicle parked at *Li'l Tykes Schoolhouse* at 5700 Cleaves Circle in Arlington.

As Deputies took the theft report, the credit card companies called the victim saying three cards had already been used at the Cache' and Guess stores at Wolfchase Galleria and the Exxon station at Germantown Parkway at Club Parkway.

Employees at the Cache' store later identified the suspects from the store's security camera. Both women were black and in their twenties. Each wore a black tee shirt and blue jeans.
