Teenager Charged with Business Burglaries

An Arlington teenager was arrested by Shelby County Sheriff's Deputies today for burglarizing a Brunswick convenience store last weekend. The same teenager has also been linked to another business burglary in Tipton County.

About 2 a.m. last Saturday, Shelby County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a burglar alarm at the A & M Market in the 7300 block of Brunswick Road.

The glass front doors had been broken and someone had shot the lock that secured the doors. Money was taken from the cash register.

Within an hour, there was another burglary in Tipton County. Tipton County detectives believe the same young man burglarized a convenience store in the Burlison area. Nothing was taken during that burglary.

Tipton County Deputies arrested him shortly after the burglary when he returned to the store to get a tire iron believed to have been used during the burglary. The teenager was also charged with possession of marijuana.
