### **U.S. MARSHALS ARREST MEMPHIS VIOLENT FUGITIVE**

**Memphis, TN** – Today, the U.S. Marshals Mid-South Fugitive Task Force arrested Rolando Baker (23). Baker had warrants issued in Shelby County for Aggravated Rape, Aggravated Burglary, Assault-Threat Bodily Harm and Resisting Official Detention.

Task Force members approached the house where Baker was believed to be living. As Task Force members entered the home Baker attempted to elude capture by trying to run out the back door. However, Task Force members had surrounded the house, were able to stop and arrest Baker without incident. Baker was transported and is currently being held at the Shelby County Jail.

The U.S. Marshals Mid-South Fugitive Task Force Memphis Division is a multi-agency task primarily comprised of Deputy U.S. Marshals, Shelby County Sheriff's Deputies, West Memphis Police and Tennessee State Probation and Parole.
