Klondike Students to Receive Funds from Sheriff's Office Golf Tournament

Shelby County Sheriff Mark H. Luttrell, Jr. and members of his command staff will present \$6,000 to the students and faculty of Klondike Elementary School in North Memphis next week. Klondike Elementary is the *"Adopt-A-School"* for the Shelby County Sheriff's Office.

The presentation will be made Tuesday, December 15th at 10 a.m. in the school's auditorium at 1250 Vollentine Avenue.

The money was raised from a charity golf tournament sponsored by the Sheriff's Office on November 6th at Edmund Orgill Golf Course in Millington.
