Announce that we will be accepting applications for the position of **Corrections Deputy** for our next Academy Class to start on August 16, 2010. We will begin accepting applications:

WE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS PRIOR TO THE ABOVE DATE. RESUMES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN PLACE OF AN APPLICATION.

The position of Corrections Deputy is an entry level position under direct supervision and is responsible for the security and maintenance of Shelby County Jail Operations in accordance with established policies and procedures. The Minimum Qualifications for Corrections Deputy are:

1. Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of a G.E.D. Certificate.
2. A minimum age of 21 at the time of application.
3. Be of high moral character.
4. "Not have been released or discharged under any other than honorable discharge from any of the armed forces of the United States."
5. Must not have been convicted of or pleaded guilty to, or entered a plea of no contest to any felony charge or to any violation of any federal or state laws or city ordinances relating to force, violence, theft, dishonesty, gambling, liquor or controlled substances. (Applicants will be screened for felony/misdemeanor record.)
6. Attend and successfully complete a basic training school/academy.

Applicants WILL BE REQUIRED to produce documents verifying compliance with the aforementioned minimum qualifications (high school diploma or G.E.D), as well as SS Card and Drivers license or State ID. Applicants will also have to submit to and successfully complete a physical agility test, written examination, comprehensive background investigation and, after a conditional offer of employment, medical and psychological assessments and drug screen.

**Other special requirements of the position include:**

- **Must be willing to work various shifts, holidays and weekends.**
- **Must reside in Shelby County by date of employment, and must remain a resident of Shelby County.**
- **All new Shelby County employees must receive their payroll check through direct deposit as a condition of employment.**
