Burglars Smash Storefront and Take ATM Machine

Shelby County Sheriff's Deputies continue their search for at least 3 men who stole an automatic teller machine (ATM) from an east Shelby County convenience store early today.

Just after 2:30 a.m., burglars crashed a Ford F 350 truck through a storefront window of the Shelby Market at 6882 Macon Road. The market was closed at the time of the burglary.

The burglars put a rope around the ATM machine and pulled it from its foundation which was bolted to the floor. Surveillance pictures show the men load the machine into the back of the landscaping truck and drive away.

Sheriff's detectives say a light blue minivan or SUV was also involved in the burglary. That vehicle was parked near the truck and followed it out of the parking lot.

About three hours after the burglary, Memphis Police officers spotted the landscaping truck in the parking lot of a nearby apartment building. The suspects and ATM machine were missing. Detectives determined the truck had been recently stolen from a landscaping business in Fayette County.
