### **Woman Walking Critically Hurt -Deputies Search for Hit and Run Driver**

An Atoka woman walking near Rosemark late last night remains in critical condition this morning at the Regional Medical Center. Deputies are searching for the driver of the pick-up truck that hit her.

Sheriff's Office Traffic Investigators say Crystal Banks, 38, was walking north on Rosemark Road near Tracy Road just before midnight last night.

That's when a small dark-colored pick-up truck knocked down Banks and kept going. A passerby found Ms. Banks and called Deputies.

Investigators say the front of the truck may be damaged on the right side near the headlight. Due to Ms. Banks condition, not much else is known about what happened.
