Deputies Search for Older Model Truck Involved In Hit and Run Incident



Sheriff's Office Traffic Investigators now believe an older model Chevy or GMC truck may have hit a woman walking late last night in the Rosemark area. The woman remains in extremely critical condition at the Regional Medical Center tonight.

Sheriff's Deputies found pieces of the truck on Rosemark Road near Tracy Road where it hit Crystal Banks, 38, of Atoka. Banks was walking north facing traffic when the truck knocked her down and sped away. A motorist found Ms. Banks lying on the side of the road.

Deputies spent much of the day comparing the truck parts with various models. They determined the truck involved may be a 1982 – 1985 Chevrolet S-10 or GMC S-15 pick-up, blue or green in color, with damage to the right front headlight area. Investigators believe the owner of the truck may also reside in the Atoka or South Tipton County.
