### **Deputies Charge Teenagers for Home Invasion and Robbery**

Two teenagers have been charged with a home invasion and robbery last month in northeast Shelby County. Sheriff's detectives say one of the teenagers who planned the crime formerly lived with the victim who had allowed the young man to live at his home.

Sheriff's investigators arrested Cadarius Mister, 19, of Memphis, last night. Mister's 16 year-old accomplice was taken into custody late this afternoon.

Detectives say on the evening of October 5, Mister, called Mark Perkins who lives in the 4300 block of Elysian Drive. Mister, who had lived with the Perkins family about a year ago, arranged to meet Perkins at a nearby grocery store to pay off a debt. The meeting, however, was a ploy.

Moments after Perkins backed out of his driveway, Mister and the other teenager slipped into Perkins' home through an open garage door. Mister put on a Halloween mask and the other teenager hid his face with a shirt.

The two then forced Perkins' wife into a bedroom and robbed her of cash, credit cards and a checkbook. She was not hurt.

Both teenagers have been charged with Aggravated Burglary and Robbery. The other teenager's picture won't be released.
